- 10:00 Pick-up at Thruway Exit 44 (Canandaigua/Farmington) Park & Ride (Plastermill Road, Farmington).
- 10:30 Pick-up at Avon/Lakeville Park & Ride, Exit 9, Rt. 390 next to Quicklee's.
- 11:00 Arrive at the **historic Yard of Ale**, 3226 Genesee St. (Rt.63), Piffard for a **sit-down lunch with your choice of** Prime Rib of Beef, Chicken Parmesan, Chicken Marsala or Garlic Shrimp Pasta with a side of smashed potatoes, sauteed vegetables, garden salad and rolls, coffee or soda. The Yard of Ale was once a 19th century tavern and inn along a canal and stagecoach route used to transport the abundant agricultural crops that the Genesee Valley was fast becoming famous for.
- 12:30 pm After lunch, transfer to **Letchworth State Park** (2640 Park Road, Mt. Morris), meet your **step-on guide**, and enjoy **a tour of Letchworth**, "The Grand Canyon of the East". Learn of the culture and history of the the first inhabitants of Western New York while visiting the **William Pryor Letchworth Museum**. See the **Seneca Council House**, and **Mary Jemison Cabin** and hear the fascinating story of her being a captive of the Senecas, becoming the wife of Chief Hiokaloo, and of her great influence in the Seneca council.
- 3:00 Enjoy a **tour of East Hill Creamery** where you will learn about the family-owned dairy farm and cheese making & aging processes, followed by a **tasting of their alpine and artisan specialties!**
- 4:00 Depart from the Creamery on your return trip home, enjoying the Fall Foliage en route.
- 5:00 - 6:00 Estimated time of return to Avon/Lakeville, Canandaigua and Clifton Springs.

TERMS & CONDITIONS - DAY TOURS

Participant Agreement

By submitting a Registration Form and payment for any Bus America Day Tour, individuals agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of participation and cancellation as indicated below. Any individual tour may have additional terms and/or conditions that apply that and will be indicated on the specific tour flyer - travelers should review all tour documentation thoroughly prior to registering. Tours will be operated in accordance with all public health requirements and guidelines in place for the particular location/s at the time of the tour. Travelers will be required to cooperate with these requirements to participate, and failure to do so may result in a traveler being dismissed from a tour without refund.

Price/Group Size: Tour prices are based on a minimum group size. If tour enrollments do not reach the required minimum group size, Bus America will offer the travelers the option to transfer their registration to another tour or receive a refund. Operational decisions will be made no later than 2 weeks prior to a scheduled tour.

Reservation and Payment Schedule: Reservations will be confirmed when a completed Registration Form is submitted with the tour deposit or full payment as indicated on the tour flyer. Registrations are accepted by mail, by phone, or online – see Registration Form for instructions and details. Generally, full payment for Day Tours are due 30-45 days prior to departure, however, each tour flyer will indicate the due dates for deposits and balances, and/or full payment.

Tour Schedule: Prior to departure, Bus America will notify travelers if any changes are necessary to the pick-up, return, or activity time schedule that is indicated on the initial flyer. Pick up locations are subject to change as approximately 8 travelers are needed at each pick up location. Your tour manager will always do their best to adhere to the original time schedule as planned, however, cannot be held responsible for deviations or tardiness caused by unforeseen factors such as weather, traffic, etc. Please arrive 10 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time, tours cannot wait for late travelers.

Tipping / Gratuities: Gratuities for tour managers and motorcoach drivers are included in all Bus America prices. However, travelers should feel free to express their gratitude for exceptional service through additional gratuities on the day of services at their own discretion.

Traveler Documentation: Participants must comply with identification or documentation requirements as indicated on the tour flyer, such as a photo I.D., and/or (for Canada) a Passport, Passport Card, or Enhanced Drivers' License.

Cancellation Policy: Day tour cancellations are accepted by phone, mail, or email to info@grouptoursinc.com. Refunds will be provided within 15-30 days from the date of cancellation. The following cancellation penalties apply:

30 days or more before departure
29 to 14 days before departure
13 to 1 day before departure or "no shows"

Penalty*

\$40 penalty + any non-refundable ticket costs (if applicable)
100% of tour price (no refund)
