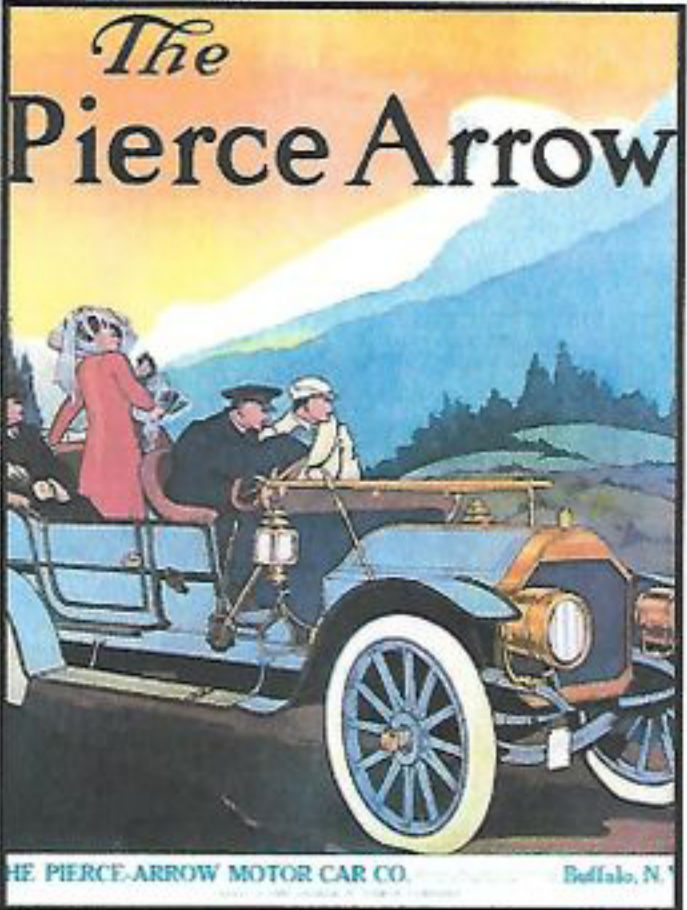

You'll go behind-the-scenes with a tour of how newspapers are made that gives the reader an informative look at how the newspaper goes from the press to the readers front door! During the tour, guests will have the opportunity to chat with a reporter while viewing the newsroom, other highlights include seeing the press in action, the warehouse, offices and more. This is a walking tour through different floors of the building. Elevators are available.

Arrive at Chef's Restaurant (291 Seneca St., Buffalo) for a buffet lunch, including salad, rigatoni, rolls, roast turkey with stuffing & gravy, roast beef au jus, mashed potatoes, corn, cannoli and coffee.

Arrive at the Buffalo Transportation Pierce-Arrow Museum (263 Michigan Ave., Buffalo) for a guided tour, followed by time to browse on your own in the Museum & Gift Shop. The Pierce-Arrow Museum preserves the company's long & prestigious history; its cars were symbols of wealth & status during one of Buffalo's most significant eras of prosperity. See the historic automobiles, bicycles, and Pierce-Arrow memorabilia as well as a 1920's filling station designed by Frank Lloyd Wright.
