7:30 am Depart by chartered motorcoach from the Allegany Community Center (Birch Run Road, Allegany, NY) for Buffalo. Rest stop en route

Arrive at Naval Park (1 Naval Park Cove) and board your red Buffalo Double Decker Tour Bus, which was imported from England and seats 65 persons including 44 seats on top and 21 seats in lower level (one step to lower level and 5 stairs to reach the upper level). LOWER LEVEL TO BE OCCUPIED BY DISABLED PERSONS FIRST. Your 90 minute tour will be led by Officer O'Connor (dressed as an 1860s-era Buffalo policeman) and is a humorous & personable general overview sightseeing tour of Buffalo's architecture, downtown and waterfront including some little-known historical details.

11:00 After the tour reboard your bus and transfer to Buffalo RiverWorks (359 Ganson Street, Buffalo).

11:30 Arrive at the dock and board the **Grand Lady**, an 80 foot yacht style luxury cruise vessel.

12:00 pm Depart on a Grand Lady Luncheon Cruise on the Buffalo River. The trip features narration about the points of interest along the route, as well as a three-course plated meal with choice of entree. Enjoy a relaxing afternoon on the water!

3:30 Reboard your motorcoach and depart on your return trip home.
