One of the most notable in the U.S., the Museum focuses on Curtiss' innovative accomplishments as an aviation pioneer and early motorcycle manufacturer. See vintage and antique collections of aircraft, motorcycles, wooden boats, automobiles, and bicycles during your guided tour of the Museum, which is located in Curtiss' hometown.
- 11:15 Depart from the Museum and continue on to Sorge's Restaurant in Corning.
- 11:45 Arrive at Sorge's (68 West Market St., Corning) and enjoy a served lunch; please indicate your entree choice on the registration form below: Chicken Parm with a side of spaghetti, Roast Beef with mashed potatoes, or Haddock Fish Sandwich with french fries. - 1:15 pm Depart from Sorge's and transfer to Corning Museum of Glass.
