- 12:00 pm Depart on a Grand Lady Luncheon Cruise on the Buffalo River. The trip features narration about the points of interest along the route, as well as a three-course plated meal with choice of entree. Enjoy a relaxing afternoon on the water!
Lunch Menu: Includes fresh fruit, garlic bread sticks, choice of entree, dessert, coffee, tea, and soda.
