Day 1 Departure

Depart on your **overnight, trans-Atlantic flight to Dubrovnik, Croatia (with one connection).**

Day 2 Croatia Arrival

Arrive early this afternoon and meet your **local motorcoach and guide.** Depart on a **panoramic orientation tour of Dubrovnik**, including the city walls, cobblestoned streets, and stunning architecture of the Old Town, including stops to see Rector's Palace, Minceta Tower, Cathedral of Virgin Mary, and the Franciscan Monastery. Check into your hotel and have some time to rest or explore the city further at your leisure. Dinner is on your own this evening. **Overnight in Dubrovnik.**

Day 3 Dubrovnik & Korcula

After **breakfast at your hotel** this morning, enjoy a **guided walking tour of Dubrovnik**, a historic walled city on the Adriatic Sea. Conclude your tour with a walk up Srd Hill for spectacular views of the city and the Dalmatian coastline. After some free time, check out and depart by **motorcoach** for the beautiful island of Korcula. Check into your hotel and enjoy a **walking tour of old town Korcula** en route to **dinner** with your group. **Overnight in Korcula Town.**

Day 4 Korkula & Marco Polo House

This morning, enjoy a **visit to Marco Polo House**, birthplace of the 'world's most famous traveler'. The remainder of the day is free to enjoy the splendors of Korkula town and the island. Dinner is on your own this evening. **Overnight in Korkula Town.**

Day 5 Ferry to Split & Tour

The morning is at your leisure prior to checking out mid-day. Transfer by **ferry to Split**, the largest city in Croatia's Dalmatian region. On arrival enjoy, a brief **orientation tour** en route to your hotel. Dinner and the evening are on your own. **Overnight in Split.**

Day 6 Split Sightseeing & Free Time

This morning, enjoy a **guided walking tour of Split**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, featuring the Silver Gate, Cathedral and Bell Tower of Saint Domnius. The afternoon is at your leisure for individual sightseeing and shopping. **Overnight in Split.**

Day 7 Plitvice National Park & Pula

This morning transfer north to Istria, the largest peninsula in the Adriatic Sea. En route, stop to **visit Plitvice Lakes National Park**, the oldest national park in southeast Europe, famous for its cascading lakes of distinctive colors. Later this afternoon transfer to your special rustic inn accommodations located outside Buje. **Dinner and overnight near Buje, Istria.**

Day 8 Foodie Tour & Cooking Lesson

Spend today enjoying a 'foodie tour' visiting several towns in the region and learning about local specialties, including the special black and white truffle, that are found in this region and celebrated every Fall in the town of Livade's annual truffle festival. In addition to learning about this delicacy, you will explore and experience many other native food products of Istria and Croatia today, and participate in a hand-on cooking lesson. Dinner is on your own this evening. **Overnight near Buje, Istria.**

Day 9 Free Day in Buje / Istria

Today is a free day for you to explore the countryside or seaside at your leisure - walk, bike or just relax and enjoy the atmosphere and amenities at the hotel! Tonight, enjoy a special **farewell dinner.** **Overnight near Buje, Istria.**

Day 10 Return Flight

Transfer to the Zagreb airport for your **return, trans-Atlantic flight (with one connection).**
