Warsaw, Poland

Day 1 **Departure**
Depart on your **overnight, trans-Atlantic flight to Berlin, Germany (with connection(s))**.

Day 2 **Berlin Arrival, Tour & Terror Museum**
Arrive in Berlin and meet your **tour director and motorcoach**, and then depart on a **guided tour of Berlin**, highlighting the city's WWII history, featuring Kindertransport Memorial, Gleis 17 Memorial at Grunewald Station, the Flak towers, Moltke Bridge, Niederkirchnerstrasse, and a **visit to the Topography of Terror Museum** – a history museum built on the grounds of the former SS and Gestapo headquarters. Check into your hotel after the tour. **Dinner and overnight in Berlin.**

Day 3 **Berlin Museums & Reichstag**
After **breakfast at your hotel**, visit the **Jewish Museum**, dedicated to Jewish history and art. Next, visit the **Checkpoint Charlie Museum**, named after the famous crossing point on the Berlin Wall between East and West Germany during the Cold War. Later today, **visit to the Reichstag (Parliament)**, where you will ride an elevator up to its famous glass dome for a beautiful vista of Berlin from the observation platform, and then have some free time. **Dinner and overnight in Berlin.**

Day 4 **Train to Warsaw & Tour**
Check out this morning and transfer to the train station for your **train to Warsaw, Poland**. Meet your local motorcoach on arrival and depart on a **guided tour of Warsaw**, featuring the Old Town, Royal Castle, Presidential Palace, and the Jewish Cemetery. **Dinner and overnight in Warsaw.**

Day 5 **Jewish Ghetto Tour & Zoo**
Spend the morning exploring the area that was the **Jewish Ghetto**, the largest of all the Jewish ghettos in Nazi-occupied Europe during WWII. This afternoon, enjoy a visit to the **Warsaw Zoo**, home to over 4,200 animals representing more than 500 species, followed by some free time. **Dinner and overnight in Warsaw.**

Day 6 **Auschwitz-Birkenau & Krakow**
After **breakfast**, transfer by motorcoach to Krakow, Poland.

Day 6 **Continued**
Stop en route to **visit the Auschwitz-Birkenau Memorial and Museum**, which includes the German concentration camps Auschwitz I and Auschwitz II-Birkenau, devoted to the memory of the murders in both camps during World War II. Continue on to Krakow for **dinner and overnight.**

Day 7 **Krakow Tour & Schindler Factory**
This morning, depart on a **guided tour of Krakow**, the only major Polish city to escape destruction during WWII. You will see the Krakow Ghetto, Old Town, Jagiellonian University, Cloth Hall, St. Mary's Basilica, and Wawel Castle. Also **tour the Oskar Schindler Factory**, an interactive museum housed in the former enamel factory of Oskar Schindler, the Nazi industrialist who famously saved the lives of members of his Jewish labor force during the Holocaust. **Dinner and overnight in Krakow.**

Day 8 **Bus to Salzburg**
After **breakfast**, check out and depart by motorcoach through southern Czech Republic for Salzburg, Austria, making stops along the way (time permitting). Arrive in Salzburg late today and check into your hotel. **Dinner and overnight in Salzburg.**

Day 9 **Salzburg & Sound of Music Tours**
This morning, depart on a **guided tour of Salzburg**, featuring Mozartplatz, the Residenz, the Glockenspiel, Salzburg Cathedral, and Mozart's birthplace. Later, enjoy a **'Sound of Music tour'** in the Austrian countryside, featuring many of the sites and vistas from the famous story about the von Trapp family during WWII. **Dinner and final overnight in Salzburg.**

Day 10 **Return**
Transfer to the airport and board your **return, trans-Atlantic flight to the United States.**
