## Day 1 Arrival, Arlington & Monuments Tour

Assemble with your group early this morning and depart by **private chartered motorcoach** for the Washington, D.C. metro area. Rest stops and a lunch stop (at your own expense) will be made en route. On arrival late this afternoon, take a **trolley tour through Arlington National Cemetery**, featuring stops to see U.S. Marine Corps War Memorial, the Kennedy gravesites, U.S. Coast Guard Memorial, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, and The Arlington House (Robert E. Lee Memorial). After **dinner with your group**, visit the Iwo Jima Memorial, Air Force Memorial, and the Pentagon Memorial before proceeding to Chevy Chase, MD. **Overnight at the National 4-H Conference Center (nighttime security guards included).**



## Day 2 Capitol Hill Tour, The Smithsonian & Monuments Illumination Tour

After **breakfast**, transfer to downtown D.C. and enjoy a **tour of Capitol Hill (Congress, the Supreme Court, and the Library of Congress)**. Afterwards, proceed (on foot) to Pennsylvania Avenue where you will have group photo ops in front of the White House. Have time for lunch (at your own expense), and then enjoy the afternoon **visiting the Smithsonian Museums** - including the Air & Space Museum, Natural History Museum, American History Museum, and the African American History and Culture Museum. After **dinner tonight (food court cash dole)**, enjoy an **Illuminations Tour of the National Monuments**, including the FDR, Jefferson, Vitenam, Korean War, Lincoln, World War II and MLK Memorials. **Overnight at the 4-H Conference Center (nighttime security guards included).**

## Day 3 Spy Museum & Return

After **breakfast**, check out and transfer to Capitol Hill for a **professional group photo at the U.S. Capitol!** Next, visit the **International Spy Museum**, dedicated to the tradecraft, history and contemporary role of espionage. After lunch (at your own expense), board your motorcoach and depart on your return trip. A rest stop and a fast food dinner stop (at your own expense) will be made en route.
