#### Day 1 Montréal Arrival & Tour

Depart early this morning by **chartered motorcoach** for Montréal, Canada. Arrive early this afternoon and meet your **local guide** for a **city tour** – including the modern heart of the city, Place Ville-Marie, McGill University, Old Montréal, Notre Dame Basilica, the Vieux Port, Place Jacques-Cartier, Chinatown, and Olympic Park, site of the 1976 Summer Olympics. Check into your hotel and then have **dinner with your group – a feast in the style of 17<sup>th</sup>-century French Canada at *Le Cabaret du Roy*. Overnight in Montréal.**

#### Day 2 Québec City & Beaupré

After **breakfast**, depart for Québec City, the cradle of French civilization in North America. Meet your **local guide** for a **city tour**, beginning in **New Québec**, where you will see Parliament Hill and the Plains of Abraham. Continue on to the **Vieille Ville**, where the narrow, cobblestone streets are lined with 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> century buildings. See the historic Chateau Frontenac, Place Royale, the Quartier Petit-Champlain, and Vieux Port. Later this afternoon, travel north along the St-Lawrence River for an **excursion to the Beaupré Coast**, where you will visit the pilgrimage site of **Sainte Anne de Beaupré** with its monumental Basilica, **Montmorency Falls**, and the open-air bread ovens of **Chez Marie**. Return to Québec City and check into your hotel, then have **dinner with your group** in the old city. After dinner enjoy a presentation of *The Québec Experience*, a 3D sound and light show. Overnight in Québec City.

#### Day 3 Artillery Park & Disco Cruise

Depart this morning for the Plains of Abraham for a **guided tour of Artillery Park Heritage Site**. Since the 17<sup>th</sup> century, Artillery Park has played an important role in defending Québec as the main barracks for the city as well as the country's first arsenal. After the tour, enjoy a **Costume Workshop** with activities focusing on the life of the French & British soldiers that stayed in Artillery Park during the Colonial Era. Return to the Old City for lunch on your own, followed by a **ride up to the top of l'Observatoire de la Capitale** for a magnificent panoramic view of Québec City! The remainder of the afternoon enjoy souvenir shopping in the old city. This evening, enjoy a **dinner of French cuisine** followed by a **disco dance cruise on the St-Lawrence River aboard. Final overnight in Québec City.**

#### Day 4 Return Trip

Check out and board your motorcoach for your return trip. Stops for lunch and dinner (at your own expense) will be made en route.

#### Documents Needed

**Proof of citizenship is required to cross the USA/Canada border. Students under age 19 will need a passport or a copy of their birth certificate (with photo ID if possible). Adults will need a passport or passport card. Travelers not born in the US - call for additional information.**
