Chateau Frontenac – Québec

Day 1 Québec Tour, Dinner & Caleche

Assemble with your group early this morning and depart by **chartered motorcoach** for Québec City, the cradle of French civilization in North America. Arrive this afternoon, meet your **local guide**, and check into your hotel. After some time to settle in, depart on a **walking tour of Old Québec City**, where the streets are lined with 17th and 18th century buildings. See the Fortifications and the Chateau Frontenac, a green-turreted castle, which towers over the old city and was once the administrative and military headquarters of New France. You will also walk down to the lower city to visit the Quartier Petit-Champlain, Vieux Port and Place Royale. Enjoy **dinner with your group**, followed by a **horse-drawn Calèche ride**. **Overnight in Québec City.**

Day 2 Beaugré Coast, Zipline, Dance Cruise

After **breakfast at your hotel**, travel north of Québec City along the St-Lawrence River for an **excursion to the Beaugré Coast**, where you will see the pilgrimage site of **Sainte Anne de Beaugré** with its monumental Basilica, and nearby **Ile d'Orleans**, an island that exemplifies the traditional lifestyle of rural Québec. En route you will visit **Parc de la Chute-Montmorency** and stop for a visit to the **woodcarver shop, Atelier Paré**. After lunch on your own, continue on to visit **Canyon Sainte-Anne**, a spectacular steep-sided gorge with majestic Sainte Anne Falls

and three suspension bridges. Your guides will take you on a **Via Ferrata** (protected climbing path) along the cliffs and down into the gorge beneath the waterfall, where you will end your journey with a 60-meter high **zip line farewell!** Return to Québec City for some shopping time and **dinner with your group**, followed by a **disco dance cruise on the St-Lawrence River**. **Overnight in Québec City.**

Day 3

Sugar Shack & Return

After **breakfast** this morning, check out and have some free time for shopping or group activities in the old town. Then transfer to the countryside to **visit a Sugar Shack**, where you will enjoy a guided tour and visit to the Maple Museum & Trapper's Camp, as well as a traditional **Québécois lunch, accompanied by folkloric music and dancing!** Depart for home mid-afternoon.

Documents Needed For This Trip

Students (under age 19) will need a passport or birth certificate with photo ID. Also, a "Parental Permission to Travel to Canada" form is required to cross the US/Canada border (will be provided). **Travelers 19 years of age or older** will need a passport, passport card, or NYS enhanced driver's license. Travelers not born in the US should call our office for additional information. **Non-US Citizens** may need to obtain a Visa, please contact our office.
