Day 1 Flight to Phoenix

Meet your group at the airport and depart on your **flight to Phoenix, Arizona (with one connection)**. Meals at your own expense during travel. On arrival, transfer to your hotel for check in. Enjoy a **pizza party** with your classmates tonight at the hotel. **Overnight in Phoenix.**

Day 2 Phoenix, Sedona, Wild West Dinner

After **breakfast at your hotel**, check out and depart on a **guided panoramic tour of Phoenix**, the state capital, including the Papago Park, Saint Mary's Basilica, Rosson House, the Phillip Darrell Duppa House, and the capitol buildings. After lunch, transfer to **Sedona**, a beautiful desert town surrounded by red-rock buttes, steep canyon walls and pine forests. Enjoy a **short orientation tour and a visit the Sedona Heritage Museum**, which presents the history of the Sedona area, from post-Civil War days to the present and is composed of 3 historic landmark buildings, a tent house replica, and a restored movie set building. Later this evening, enjoy a **wild west dinner show with entertainment!** **Overnight in Sedona.**

Day 3 Devils Bridge Hike & GC IMAX

Enjoy a **hike to the famous Devil's Bridge**, a natural arch formed in sandstone in the mountain ridge outside Sedona before continuing on to south rim area of the Grand Canyon.

Day 3 Continued

This evening, enjoy the famous **Grand Canyon IMAX Show** before **dinner with your group. Overnight near the Grand Canyon.**

Day 4 Touring and Free Time

Today is reserved for a **full day of guided touring in and around Grand Canyon National Park**, encompassing 277 miles of the Colorado River and its adjacent lands, including the Grand Canyon, which is up to 1 mile deep and 18 miles wide in places. Your day will find you exploring the multitude of layered bands of red rock and millions of years of geological history as you visit all of the best viewpoints (such as Mather Point, Yavapai Observation Station, Lookout Studio and Lipan Point) and also hike a short distance into the canyon, learning about this extraordinary natural wonder and its origin. **Dinner and final overnight near the Grand Canyon.**

Day 5 Hoover Dam & Return Flight

Check out this morning and transfer to Las Vegas, Nevada. Stop en route to **visit the Hoover Dam**, a concrete arch-gravity dam in the Black Canyon of the Colorado River, on the border between the U.S. states of Nevada and Arizona, constructed between 1931 and 1936 during the Great Depression. Enjoy a drive through the Las Vegas Strip en route to the airport for your **return overnight flight (with one connection)**. **Return home on Day 6, early morning.**
