Friday, May 25 Departure & Montréal Tour

Depart early this morning by **private motorcoach** for Montréal, Canada – the largest French-speaking city in North America. On arrival, meet your **local guide** at Place Jacques-Cartier and have time for lunch (at your own expense) in the Vieille Ville. This afternoon, enjoy a **guided tour of Montreal**. Begin in the old city, where you will visit the Vieux Port and the **interior of Notre-Dame Basilica**, a masterpiece of neo-Gothic architecture. Continue on to the modern heart of the city, where you will see Place Ville-Marie, the Underground City, Place des Arts, McGill University, Chinatown, Mont Royal, and the Shrine of St Joseph. Check into your hotel and then have **dinner with your group**, followed by a **Ghost Tour of Old Montreal**, where you will discover some of the city's more morbid legends and stories, along with some anecdotes of still unexplained phenomena. **Overnight in Montréal (hotel security included).**

Saturday May 26 Sightseeing & Lasertag

After **breakfast at your hotel**, transfer to visit **Olympic Park**, the site of the 1976 Summer Olympics, featuring a **visit to the Biodome**, part of Canada's natural science museum complex, which allows visitors to walk through replicas of four ecosystems found in the Americas. After lunch (at your own expense) this afternoon, enjoy a **scavenger hunt in Old Montreal** with your group. After **dinner**, enjoy a fun evening of **lasertag** with your group at *Défi Laser*. **Overnight in Montréal (hotel security included).**

Sunday, May 27

Market & Return

After **breakfast at your hotel**, check out and then depart for some free time at the **Atwater Market**, a farmers' market located in the Saint-Henri area of Montreal. The interior market is home to many butchers and the *Première Moisson* bakery and restaurant. The outside market has many farmers' stalls selling both local and imported produce. After time for lunch (at your own expense), board your **private motorcoach** for your return trip home. A late evening return is expected.
