9:15 am Depart by chartered motorcoach from the Akron Newstead Senior Center, 5691 Cummings Road, Akron for LeRoy. Park on the far side of the parking lot.

10:00 Arrive at the Jell-O Gallery (23 E. Main St., LeRoy) and discover the intriguing story of Jell-O, invented in LeRoy in 1897. Jell-O has a unique history such as why did the inventor sell his Jell-O rights for \$450? Exhibits include original advertising art, molds, collectables, recipe books, and more.



You will also have a tour of the historic LeRoy Mansion, which was built in 1822 by Jacob LeRoy and showcases a century of history, including Ingham University (the first American university for women) and the story of the 86,000 acre Triangle Tract, a land deal controlled by the LeRoy family. See the 1930s kitchen with all its "modern" conveniences and gadgets. Then step downstairs to look at Charlotte LeRoy's original 1820s open hearth kitchen and learn what was cooking!

11:30 Depart from the Jell-O Gallery & LeRoy Mansion for lunch.

12:00 pm Enjoy a Served Lunch at the D&R Depot Restaurant (63 Lake St., LeRoy). When you sign up, please indicate your entree: Italian seasoned charbroiled Haddock, broiled center cut Pork Chop, or Swiss Steak topped with peppers & onions. Your lunch will also include potato, vegetable, homemade breads, beverage, and dessert (Key Lime Jell-O pie).

1:15 Depart from lunch & return to the LeRoy House (23 E. Main St.), where you will meet your step-on guide.


1:45 Enjoy a guided Barn Quilts Tour, which began as a bicentennial project for the Town of LeRoy. The first quilt, "JELL-O Jigglers" was painted in July 2011 at the annual Oatka Festival. Now, more than 100 quilts on barns, garages, homes, silos, and businesses in this rural Genesee County community tell tales in the patterns on quilt squares and represent the pride shared by the people of LeRoy.

3:15 At the end of your tour, depart on the return trip home.

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TERMS & CONDITIONS - DAY TOURS

Participant Agreement

By submitting a Registration Form and payment for any Bus America Day Tour, individuals agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of participation and cancellation as indicated below. Any individual tour may have additional terms and/or conditions that apply that and will be indicated on the specific tour flyer - travelers should review all tour documentation thoroughly prior to registering. Tours will be operated in accordance with all public health requirements and guidelines in place for the particular location/s at the time of the tour. These may include, but are not limited to requirements for face coverings, social distancing and venue or vehicle capacity limitations, submitting Covid-19 Waivers and health screening information, and/or other measures. All participants will be required to cooperate with any such requirements to participate, and failure to do so may result in a traveler being dismissed from a tour without refund.

Price/Group Size: Tour prices are based on a minimum group size. If tour enrollments do not reach the required minimum group size, Bus America will offer the travelers the option to transfer their registration to another tour or receive a full refund. Operational decisions will be made no later than 2 weeks prior to a scheduled tour.

Reservation and Payment Schedule: Reservations will be confirmed when a completed Registration Form is submitted with the tour deposit or full payment as indicated on the tour flyer. Registrations are accepted by mail, by phone, or online – see Registration Form for instructions and details. Generally, full payment for Day Tours are due 30-45 days prior to departure, however, each tour flyer will indicate the due dates for deposits and balances, and/or full payment.

Tour Schedule: Prior to departure, Bus America will notify travelers if any changes are necessary to the pick-up, return, or activity time schedule that is indicated on the initial tour flyer. On tour personnel will always do their best to adhere to the original time schedule as planned, however, cannot be held responsible for deviations or tardiness caused by unforeseen factors such as weather, traffic, etc.

Tipping / Gratuities: Basic gratuities for tour escorts and motorcoach drivers are included in all Bus America Day Tour prices. However, these individuals often work extra hard and go many 'extra miles' to make sure each traveler enjoys their day and is taken very good care of while travelling with us. Travelers should feel free to express their gratitude for exceptional service through additional gratuities on the day of services at their own discretion.

Traveler Documentation: Participants must comply with identification or documentation requirements as indicated on the tour flyer, such as a photo I.D., and/or (for Canada) a Passport, Passport Card, or Enhanced Drivers' License.

Cancellation Policy: Day tour cancellations are accepted by phone, mail, or email to cancels.grouptours@outlook.com. Refunds will be provided within 30 days from the date of cancellation. The following cancellation penalties apply:

Cancellation

30 days or more before departure

29 to 14 days before departure

13 to 1 day before departure or "no shows"

Penalty*

\$10 processing fee + non-refundable show ticket cost (if applicable)

\$40 + non-refundable show / ticket cost (if applicable)

100% of tour price (no refund)

***Exceptions:** In the event a travel provides his or her own replacement or a replacement traveler can be found, travelers will only be charged a \$10.00 processing fee. Cancellations for emergency medical reasons (accompanied by a doctor's note) will be reviewed and exceptions are possible on a case-by-case basis. Bus America will always work with our vendors and passengers to maximize refunds in the case of unexpected medical emergencies.

Responsibilities: Bus America reserves the right to make changes to a tour date or a tour itinerary due to unforeseen circumstances. Bus America, an operational division of Group Tours, Inc., acts as an agent in making and securing arrangements for group transportation, accommodations, meals, and activities.
