- 9:30 am Depart by **chartered motorcoach** from the Mendon Community Center (167 N. Main St., Honeoye Falls) for the Kent & Lockport, NY area.
- 9:45 Pick up at the Rush Fire Department (1971 Rush Mendon Road).
- 10:00 Pick-up at Scottsville Fire Hall (387 Scottsville Mumford Road). Rest stop en route (time permitting).
- 11:15 Arrive at the **Black North Inn** (14352 Ontario St, Kent), with its beautiful view of Lake Ontario, and enjoy a **buffet lunch** including chicken cutlets with an apple dijon sauce, beef tips with burgundy mushroom gravy, salad, rolls, roasted potatoes, vegetable, dessert, and coffee/tea.
- 12:45 pm Depart from the Black North Inn at the end of lunch and travel to Lockport.
- 1:30/1:45 Arrive at Lockport Locks & Erie Canal Cruises (210 Market St., Lockport) & board your boat.
- 2:00 Depart on a fun & informative two-hour cruise passing five of the original 1800's Locks. Three million gallons of water will fill Locks 34 & 35, the only double set on the Erie Canal, and raise the boat 50 feet. Pass under Lockport's "Upside Down Bridge", Lockport's "Big Bridge" (widest bridge in the U.S.), through the "deep rock cut" and under lift bridges. The lively narration by the Coast Guard Licensed Captain is also accompanied by canal music popular during the 1800's.
- 4:00 At the end of your boat ride, reboard your motorcoach and depart for home.
- 5:00-5:45 En route stop for ice cream/food (individual expense) at Tom Wahl's (283 E. Main St., Avon).
- 6:00-6:30 Estimated return time to Scottsville, Rush, and Honeoye Falls.

TERMS & CONDITIONS - DAY TOURS

Participant Agreement

By submitting a Registration Form and payment for any Bus America Day Tour, individuals agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of participation and cancellation as indicated below. Any individual tour may have additional terms and/or conditions that apply that and will be indicated on the specific tour flyer - travelers should review all tour documentation thoroughly prior to registering. Tours will be operated in accordance with all public health requirements and guidelines in place for the particular location/s at the time of the tour. Travelers will be required to cooperate with these requirements to participate, and failure to do so may result in a traveler being dismissed from a tour without refund.

Price/Group Size: Tour prices are based on a minimum group size. If tour enrollments do not reach the required minimum group size, Bus America will offer the travelers the option to transfer their registration to another tour or receive a refund. Operational decisions will be made no later than 2 weeks prior to a scheduled tour.

Reservation and Payment Schedule: Reservations will be confirmed when a completed Registration Form is submitted with the tour deposit or full payment as indicated on the tour flyer. Registrations are accepted by mail, by phone, or online – see Registration Form for instructions and details. Generally, full payment for Day Tours are due 30-45 days prior to departure, however, each tour flyer will indicate the due dates for deposits and balances, and/or full payment.

<u>Tour Schedule:</u> Prior to departure, Bus America will notify travelers if any changes are necessary to the pick-up, return, or activity time schedule that is indicated on the initial flyer. <u>Pick up locations are subject to change as approximately 8 travelers are needed at each pick up location</u>. Your tour manager will always do their best to adhere to the original time schedule as planned, however, cannot be held responsible for deviations or tardiness caused by unforeseen factors such as weather, traffic, etc. <u>Please arrive 10 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time, tours cannot wait for late travelers.</u>

<u>Tipping / Gratuities</u>: Gratuities for tour managers and motorcoach drivers are included in all Bus America prices. However, travelers should feel free to express their gratitude for exceptional service through additional gratuities on the day of services at their own discretion.

<u>Traveler Documentation:</u> Participants must comply with identification or documentation requirements as indicated on the tour flyer, such as a photo I.D., and/or (for Canada) a Passport, Passport Card, or Enhanced Drivers' License.

<u>Cancellation Policy:</u> Day tour cancellations are accepted by phone, mail, or email to <u>info@grouptoursinc.com</u>. Refunds will be provided within 15-30 days from the date of cancellation. The following cancellation penalties apply:

30 days or more before departure 29 to 14 days before departure 13 to 1 day before departure or "no shows"
