Participant Agreement

By submitting a Registration Form and payment for any Bus America Day Tour, individuals agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of participation and cancellation as indicated below. Price/Group Size: Tour prices are based on a minimum group size. Operational decisions will be made no later than 2 weeks prior to a scheduled tour.
