- 7:30 am Depart by chartered motorcoach from Henrietta Senior Center (515 Calkins Road, Henrietta).
- 8:00 Pick-up at Thruway Exit 44 (Canandaigua/Farmington) Park & Ride (Plastermill Road, Farmington).
- 8:30 Pick-up at Tops Markets (3 Clifton Springs Plaza) and proceed to Cortland, NY.
- 10:00 Arrive in Cortland and enjoy a self-guided visit to **The Central New York Living History Center** (4386 US Route 11), a massive museum complex with a diverse collection from larger than life Brockway Trucks, including a 1925 Brockway Fire Truck, to an impressive 10,000 items collected and curated by the late Ken Eaton illustrating America's Civil War to rare items of local and national political significance, and the massive collection of antique tractors.
- 12:30 pm **Lunch at the Hollywood Bar & Grill** (27 Groton Ave), a popular landmark in Cortland for over eighty years. **Entree choice:** Chicken or Veal Parmigiana, Broiled Haddock; or a Hollywood Salad. Lunches also served with salad, a potato side, soft drink/coffee/tea, and dessert.
- 2:15 **Guided Tour of the 1890 House Museum**, (37 Thompkins Street). Be transported to 19th Century Cortland and tour the castle-like estate built for the inventor and industrialist Chester Wickwire - a standing time capsule illuminating the life of the wealthy Wickwire family.
- 4:00 Begin the return home, making a stop at a central NY farm market where you can purchase locally sourced produce, meats, cheeses & more!
- 6-7:00 Estimated time of return to pick up locations.



Please arrive 10 minutes ahead of time listed at your pick-up - the bus cannot wait for late arrivals.

TERMS & CONDITIONS - DAY TOURS

Participant Agreement

By submitting a Registration Form and payment for any Bus America Day Tour, individuals agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of participation and cancellation as indicated below. Any individual tour may have additional terms and/or conditions that apply that and will be indicated on the specific tour flyer - travelers should review all tour documentation thoroughly prior to registering. Tours will be operated in accordance with all public health requirements and guidelines in place for the particular location/s at the time of the tour. Travelers will be required to cooperate with these requirements to participate, and failure to do so may result in a traveler being dismissed from a tour without refund.

Price/Group Size: Tour prices are based on a minimum group size. If tour enrollments do not reach the required minimum group size, Bus America will offer the travelers the option to transfer their registration to another tour or receive a refund. Operational decisions will be made no later than 2 weeks prior to a scheduled tour.

Reservation and Payment Schedule: Reservations will be confirmed when a completed Registration Form is submitted with the tour deposit or full payment as indicated on the tour flyer. Registrations are accepted by mail, by phone, or online – see Registration Form for instructions and details. Generally, full payment for Day Tours are due 30-45 days prior to departure, however, each tour flyer will indicate the due dates for deposits and balances, and/or full payment.

Tour Schedule: Prior to departure, Bus America will notify travelers if any changes are necessary to the pick-up, return, or activity time schedule that is indicated on the initial flyer. Pick up locations are subject to change as approximately 8 travelers are needed at each pick up location. Your tour manager will always do their best to adhere to the original time schedule as planned, however, cannot be held responsible for deviations or tardiness caused by unforeseen factors such as weather, traffic, etc. Please arrive 10 minutes prior to the scheduled departure time, tours cannot wait for late travelers.

Tipping / Gratuities: Gratuities for tour managers and motorcoach drivers are included in all Bus America prices. However, travelers should feel free to express their gratitude for exceptional service through additional gratuities on the day of services at their own discretion.

Traveler Documentation: Participants must comply with identification or documentation requirements as indicated on the tour flyer, such as a photo I.D., and/or (for Canada) a Passport, Passport Card, or Enhanced Drivers' License.

Cancellation Policy: Day tour cancellations are accepted by phone, mail, or email to info@grouptoursinc.com. Refunds will be provided within 15-30 days from the date of cancellation. The following cancellation penalties apply:

30 days or more before departure

29 to 14 days before departure

13 to 1 day before departure or "no shows"

\$40 penalty + any non-refundable ticket costs (if applicable)

100% of tour price (no refund)

FOR DAY TRIPS UNDER \$200, PAY AN ADDITIONAL \$10.00 AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION FOR BUS AMERICA'S MEDICAL CANCELLATION PROTECTION WHICH WILL PROVIDE 100% REFUND OF PROGRAM FEES FOR CANCELLATION IN THE CASE OF A DOCUMENTED MEDICAL EMERGENCY.

In the event a traveler provides his or her own replacement cancellation penalties will be waived.
